Hello everyone

Now that the dust has settled and elections are over, I would like to thank everyone who voted. I'm proud to be elected to serve you for another term at Buckinghamshire Council.

I do NOT underestimate the many challenges that lie ahead.

THE HARD WORK STARTS NOW.

The new council will be taking shape over coming months, and I will keep you informed of new developments.

One key change that took place before the elections was a restructure of our local Community Boards. In an effort to streamline and create better cost efficiencies we have reduced the number of boards from 16 down to eight. The new board for our area is the North-West Buckinghamshire Community Board.

The way the boards work will remain as before. They bring the council, groups, organisations and local people together. Their aim is to look at local issues and find ways of improving them together and anyone interested can get involved.

One of the continuing high priorities for the council is around recruiting more foster carers. We have been working hard in the past few years to improve our offer to foster carers to show our appreciation for the fantastic work they do in helping to look after the vulnerable children in our care and also as a way to recruit new carers. Our Bucks foster carers offer a safe, loving home environment to a range of children and young people and we are so grateful to each and every one of them.

During Foster Care Fortnight which runs in mid-May, we unveiled our latest range of perks and benefits for our foster carers which includes Merlin passes for families, giving free access to a range of leisure and entertainment activities across the country and also discounted rail travel. These new perks sit alongside the existing 100% rebate on council tax, free parking and other benefits that were unveiled last year.

New Timetable For Buckingham Library

Dear Library Member,

We are excited to introduce **Library Flex**, an innovative new delivery model for eight of our larger libraries. This initiative will allow us to maintain our libraries, offer longer opening hours, and make significant savings.

What is Library Flex?

Library Flex will increase the opening hours at seven of our main libraries by at least 20%, and Amersham Library's hours will increase by 129%. Staff will be available during the busiest times, with self-service technology and security measures in place during quieter times. This model also allows for wider community use of library spaces outside of staffed hours.

Temporary Opening Hours

To prepare for the launch of Library Flex, we will temporarily reduce the opening hours of the eight libraries involved from 2 June. This is to ensure that all necessary installations and tests are completed before we extend the opening hours in July and August.

A second cut took place on 17.04.25 which was outside of the schedule as was due in 28.04.25. The contractor is aware that this was outside of the schedule and that it will not be funded.






