

Come and enjoy a **felting workshop with Eve Marshall**. You may have met her in 2024 when we visited Rutland Water and Barnsdale Gardens. Eve's workshop is aimed at beginners



Eve will be working with the theme of a flower garden or meadow. We'll be doing wet felting in the morning, and needle felting in the afternoon — enabling us to learn both felting techniques.

Our pictures will be approximately A4 size. Once complete you could hang it on the wall, stitch it to a cushion or bag...

Please bring an apron, rubber gloves (for touching hot water) and small hand towel. All other materials will be supplied. We will be using 100% wool and Fairy Liquid soap. If you are allergic to wool then this is not the class for you. If you are allergic to Fairy Liquid, please bring gloves. We'll be working on trays so water is usually contained.

Talking about the charity that the group raise funds for, Jessica said:

'We're raising funds for NMPAT because we're all NMPAT alumni and all work in music or the performing arts in one way or another. From self-employed musicians who work with all the UK's leading orchestras, to the Captain of the Band of the Irish Guards, and the "Music Health Service" which provides music for people in care homes, we all learnt how to be musicians through our teachers and ensembles at NMPAT.

The Crewdson Collective was formed to play at the memorial concert of Jessica's mother, Anne Mogridge. Anne anonymously gave money for young musicians to go on residential courses and tours, who otherwise wouldn't be able to afford to go. She wanted those musicians to have the experience, and the Crewdson Collective is continuing this by raising funds through getting together and giving concerts. In a cost-of-living crisis, and with funding cuts to the arts ever present, this work is vital.'

Residents wished to discuss the planning application regarding the Land behind the Royal Oak (which is an agenda item below at 94 and 94a)

Concerns raised as follows;

- Proximity to neighboring properties
- Access for materials
- Rainwater runoff, flooding history
- Access for vehicles onto a main road, opposite a school
- Environmental impact

The Parish Council will consider the application and respond.

Residents were also encouraged to raise their objections to the planning application themselves.

It was proposed that the minutes be approved as a true and accurate record.

Item 81 – Bins – Cllr Maxwell is in correspondence with Buckinghamshire Council, a response is awaited.

Item 82 – Grasscutting – Gorrell Lane. The area has been cut back

Item 84 – Grasscutting at the Maltings - BC have confirmed that they will add the area at the Maltings to our schedule, provided that they currently have responsibility for cutting it. They require the location to be sent to them.

Item 85 b ii – First Aid Training- Clerk to obtain a quote.

Action: Clerk

Item 86 – Update received. BC to be approached for a formal sign for the recreation field. If BC are not prepared to fund it the Parish Council will obtain quotations.

Action: Cllr Maxwell

Item 87 – Village Pubs – The Red Lion – Unfortunately the community team have been unable to raise the funds and have withdrawn their bid to purchase.

Item 87 – Village Pubs – The Royal Oak – Agenda item as below at Item 94 and 94a

93. Buckinghamshire Councilors' Reports

Cllr Mahon and Cllr Fealey sent their apologies.

The Chairman noted the Code of Conduct and that County Councilors must be spoken to appropriately.

94. The Royal Oak Development (7.30pm via Teams)

Discussion with Mr Thomas French, Planning Consultant for the Tingewick Development Group regarding proposals for the site.

Mr French attended via a Teams link

- Mr French confirmed that he works for Cordage Group, a development group that has been employed by the owners of the land, Admiral Taverns, as their asset managers.
- Also part of the Cordage Group is Tingewick Developments Limited (TDL) who have submitted the current planning application and for which Mr French is the Planning Consultant.
- It was confirmed that TDL was set up for the purpose of the proposed development.
- It was confirmed that the Royal Oak and the land to the rear is all owned by Admiral Taverns
- The meeting was advised that the car park (adjacent to the Village Hall) is not part of the current application.
- It was questioned what the sale in January 2025, for the sum of £10,000, consisted of. It was noted that this was in the moratorium period and appears on the face to be at a gross undervalue if it was for the whole site as per the title plan. Mr French advised that he did not know what this sale was and would make enquires and confirm the same. **Action: T French**
- TDL will build through a third-party contractor.
- It was confirmed that TDL will continue to exist post build.
- A management company will be established, requiring 30 years of maintenance, and the prospective purchasers will be required to make a service charge to the management company.
- The plan is to establish a road to the side of the Royal Oak. Concerns regarding safety were raised.
- Concerns regarding flooding were raised, the village has a real and damaging history of flooding, it was felt that this will exacerbate flooding by run off to the Main Street
- Environmental impacts were raised as were the impact of the proposed development to neighbouring properties.



UK EMERGENCY BROADCAST TEST

On **Sunday 7 September 2025 at 3pm**, the government will carry out a national test of the Emergency Alerts system. This means most mobile phones and tablets across the UK will receive a test message, accompanied by a loud siren-like sound and vibration that will last for about 10 seconds.

The message you receive will clearly state that this is a test and that no action is required on your part. The alert will come through even if your device is set to silent mode, which is an important feature of the system designed to ensure people receive warnings in genuine emergencies.

The Emergency Alerts system serves a crucial purpose in keeping the public safe. It's used to warn people when there's a danger to life nearby, including severe weather events like storms or flooding. Since the first national test in April 2023, the system has sent five real alerts during major storms when lives were genuinely at risk.






