NEWS FROM CALLUM ANDERSON, MP

It's been another busy month across the constituency, and I wanted to update residents in Tingewick on some of the key issues I've been working on locally and nationally.

The recent announcement concerning HS2 is deeply disappointing. The news that services will not be running until at least 2039 will come as a bitter blow to rural communities across north Buckinghamshire, which have already endured years of disruption from construction and engineering works.

I support delivering the infrastructure Britain needs, but HS2 has too often been marked by mismanagement, poor oversight and a lack of accountability. Britain cannot afford a repeat of these failures, and our government is determined to ensure that future major projects are managed far more effectively.

I've also been out and about across the constituency speaking with local educators and young people as part of the government's "Growing Up in an Online World" consultation. Thank you to everyone who contributed to these conversations. How young people engage with social media is a nuanced issue, and I was grateful for the thoughtful and constructive discussions we had. I'll be submitting local feedback directly to Ministers.

I welcome the recent news on fuel duty, which I know has been a significant concern for many residents, particularly in our rural communities. The fuel duty freeze for drivers will now continue until 31 December. In addition, the fuel duty rate on red diesel – used by farmers and rail freight – will be reduced by more than a third, from 10.18p to 6.48p per litre, from 15 June until the end of the year.

With the warmer weather arriving, I'm also looking forward to launching a new Summer School programme for local young people. The programme aims to make politics feel more accessible to everyone, whatever their background.

I'm also looking forward to getting out and about in Tingewick over the summer and speaking with more residents face-to-face.

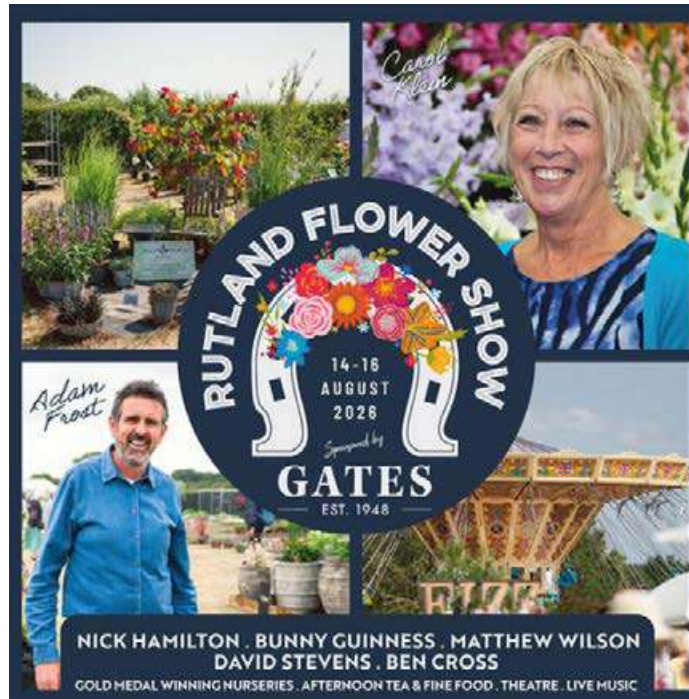

Tingewick Parish Council Update No 2

Richard Fenemore Playing Field

Following enquiries we confirm that as the small car park has been constructed within the boundary, there was no need for highways involvement. While it will help ease current parking pressures, it is not expected to provide a complete solution.

The children's play area is now complete and we are hopeful that this will become a favourite with our youngsters. During the construction of the car park and playground the trim trail was compromised therefore we will shortly be implementing a plan to reroute it.

There are two welfare units situated on the premises. These facilities are available for everyone to use when utilising the field e.g. football club. The Parish Council actively encourages all members of the community to make full use of both the grounds and the welfare facilities, promoting a welcoming and inclusive environment for all visitors. Do you know anyone who would like to hire the grounds?

Pond Area

Volunteers have continued planting bulbs, wildflowers and shrubs to improve both safety and appearance. In May, the paths and seating areas will be jet-washed and treated where necessary.

We would ask that you do not feed the ducks – the volunteers have a system in place to ensure enough food is available. Monitored feeding helps to minimise the risk of attracting vermin near homes adjacent to the pond, keeping the area safe and pleasant for everyone.

Cemetery

Work on older graves has been completed. Graves were levelled and finished with shingle and membrane to prevent future grass growth. Removal of ant hills continues.

Due to the high clay content of the soil, some newer graves have not settled as expected. Corrective work will be undertaken to level the ground without disturbing plots. In recent years, our cemetery rules have not been applied consistently, and we understand this may have caused some confusion. To encourage adherence to the rules, from September we will be removing accessories from graves and surrounding areas that do not comply with the rules. Items we remove will be stored in the Chapel for 6 months for relatives to collect at their convenience. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact clerk@tingewickparishcouncil.org.uk. *(Please see the attached Cemetery Rules for full details).*

We would like to reassure you that this decision has not been taken lightly. It is simply to ensure the grounds can be maintained safely and effectively, particularly during grass-cutting, and to meet essential health and safety requirements. Our intention is never to cause upset, and we appreciate your understanding as we carry out this necessary work.

A major hedge cutting programme is scheduled to begin on 7 September, following the end of the nesting season. The cemetery will be extended to provide additional plots in both the main burial area and the garden of remembrance. Trees and shrubs will be cut back to facilitate this work.

Significant steps have been taken to enhance the condition and appearance of the Cemetery. After years of neglect, the War Memorial will undergo a thorough cleaning and restoration, ensuring it is properly preserved and honours those commemorated. In

addition, the compost pile, which previously detracted from the overall environment, has now been removed. Further aesthetic improvements include the staining of panels, which contributes to a more cared-for and respectful atmosphere within the grounds.

Footpaths

Maintenance work on the Gorrell Close footpath was postponed following concerns raised by residents. Work will now commence 2nd week in September to remove rubbish and overgrown vegetation. Trees will be retained, with only overhanging or unsafe branches addressed. Work will continue throughout the growing season on other footpaths maintained by the Parish Council.

The Parish Council working party planned for the by-pass footpath was postponed due to weather conditions, holidays and nesting season. This will now take place in the autumn.

Best Kept Village

Judging will take place from early June. Residents and those responsible for local areas are encouraged to keep them tidy to support the village's entry.

The Parish Council is organising a litter pick/village tidy for 23rd May at 10.30 – meeting at the Village Hall. All welcome.

Community Involvement

The Parish Council regularly organises activities such as litter picks, bulb planting, and event support. Volunteers are always welcome, and anyone interested in getting involved is encouraged to make contact.

NB: The Parish Council has responded to the recent planning application for additional housing in the village. We encourage you to make yourselves heard by 8 May.

Cllr Maxwell is also awaiting details from BCC of the replacement for the equivalent of the 'local area technician', the role having changed in title from BCC.

Footpaths (rural) – Cllr Newman

Maintenance is now ongoing.

The landowner is undertaking repair work at Deadmans Walk.

Pond and Special Projects-Cllr Newman

Damaged bench at pond. Cllr Hornsey will assess for repair.

It is noted that the water level in the pond is low.
