NEWS FROM CALLUM ANDERSON, MP

Hi there,

It has certainly been a busy period in politics, and those interested can find [my statements on recent Labour Party developments on my website](#). However, my focus remains firmly on serving our communities and ensuring local voices are heard in Westminster.

This summer marks two years since I had the privilege of being elected as your Member of Parliament. To mark the occasion, I have published my second Annual Report, *Delivering Change*, reflecting on what we have achieved together across the constituency (which, again, [you can find on my website](#)).

Over the past year, my team and I have responded to more than 5,000 emails and helped residents with over 800 individual casework enquiries. Whether supporting people with housing, healthcare, education, immigration or welfare issues, helping constituents remains at the heart of everything we do.

We have continued working closely with families and schools on SEND provision, supported communities affected by flooding, and ensured local voices have been heard on important issues such as children's online safety. In Parliament, I have championed measures to strengthen the economy, improve financial education and support growing businesses, while serving as Parliamentary Private Secretary at the Department for Science, Innovation and Technology.

I have also continued visiting communities across the constituency and listening to residents' concerns. When I stood for election, I promised to be a visible and approachable local MP, and that commitment remains unchanged. I am particularly keen to ensure that communities like Tingewick have a strong voice on issues including local services, education, transport, healthcare and the cost of living.

Looking back over the past month, there has also been welcome news for local farmers. Following representations from the Buckinghamshire branch of the National Farmers' Union and farmers across north Buckinghamshire, the Government has reduced the duty rate on red diesel, biodiesel and bioblend until the end of 2026. This will help ease cost pressures facing farming businesses at a challenging time.

I also welcome the Government's plans to strengthen protections for children online. Following conversations with local families, teachers and school leaders, I know many residents are concerned about the impact of harmful content, cyberbullying and excessive screen time on young people.

With schools now breaking up for the summer holidays (and boy is it hot!), many families will be looking forward to spending more time together. The Government's [Great British Summer Savings initiative](#) will help make days out more affordable, with discounts on family attractions, children's meals and activities, alongside free bus travel throughout August for children aged 5–15 on participating services.

Open Forum – 2 members of the public were in attendance to discuss a proposed project at the old Air Field.

The proposal is for a base for homeless military veterans who will be trained on site in employable skills ie electrical skills, machinery operatives, lines of work are already available. It is early days, a team has been established to drive the project and fundraising is in process.

It was explained that potential candidates will be vetted to screen out major risks ie substance abuse, addiction and there will be supervision at all times. This will have the benefit of uplifting an old building and providing valuable skills training at the same time.

The team are forming links with other agencies who can offer support and assistance ie local councils, military veterans' charities.

The project will be for men only at this stage and limited to between six to ten participants

Defibrillator – Cllr Sullivan

The Clerk has ordered a new battery which has not yet been received. The Clerk has followed this up and was advised that it will be expedited.

Footways, Highways and Street Furniture-Cllr Maxwell

Cllr Maxwell, Cllr Hornsey and the Clerk undertook a village walk with the new highways technician and her assistant. The issues requiring repair were discussed, however it was disappointing as there will be no action regarding the serious surfacing concerns as they do not meet the 40 mm depth requirement.

Clerk has requested County Councillors to nominate Main Street as their road. Clerk wrote and will chase as no response and not here to say.

Drain at Westwell Lane – we were advised that the repair would take place on Monday (22nd June) however to date there has been no action.

Devolved services – The Clerk will contact BCC's devolved services team to enquire whether there are any other services that could be devolved to the Parish. **Action - Clerk**

It was noted that many drains are blocked with silt. BCC advise that they clear drains once every year.

Footpaths (rural) – Cllr Newman

A complaint was received that debris had been left at the top end of Gorrell Lane, it has now been cleared.

Pond and Special Projects-Cllr Newman

It was confirmed that should the pond dry out, it will be cleared.

Cemetery -Cllr Newman

The last cut was not to the standard required. Cllr Rennie has discussed concerns and attention to detail with the contractor and as remedial work was required the next cut will not be paid for.

The new play equipment has now been added to the Parish Councils' insurance policy.

105. Recreation Ground Development/S106 Funds

- a) Car Park- a temporary repair has been made and a quote has been required for a full repair.
- b) S106 Money – Trim Trail – Cllr Rennie has requested a quote which is awaited.
- c) Community Park Trust - it was confirmed that the Community Part Trust will donate some money towards further development in due course.
- d) S106 – Development at Sandpit Hill – It was confirmed that there is the potential for the Village Hall Committee to apply for s106 funds to purchase the Royal Oak car park. It is also

possible for the Parish Council to seek funding to fund a footpath to the recreation ground. It was however noted that the Parish council still strongly opposes the development.

106. Purchase of New CCTV

The CCTV at the Recreation Field requires repair but the contractor has ceased trading. There has been anti-social behaviour and instances of broken glass being left on the playing field as such it is considered essential that it is repaired.

A quote has been obtained from Austerley Technology Group to take over the existing system, upgrade and an annual maintenance fee at a total sum of £930.08

It was proposed that Austerley Technology Group take over the CCTV system as per their quotation.

107. Gorrell Lane Footpath

The clerk confirmed the legal position in that the Parish Council has no statutory power to deal with trees that they do not own. BCC is responsible for any emergency work. The Clerk has been in contact with BCC and they are aware of the issue.

Cllr Hornsey provided a summary of a very successful fete.

The accounts are being finalised but a profit has been made, and a donation will be made to Tingewick PreSchool.

Thanks extended to the Parish Councillors for their help and support.
