Welcome to the March issue of the Tingewick News.

Spring is now in the air, the crocuses are starting to bloom and it's the time of year when your thoughts might start turning to your garden. If you're not sure where to start with your garden or are looking to do something a bit "different" this year (and get discounts from local companies) then why not join the Horticultural Society? There's no Neighbourhood Watch news this month but I thought you should be made aware of a couple of the newer scams that are doing the rounds. There are emails from both TV Licencing and the DVLA Car Tax department stating that there's an error with your payment details and that you need to visit their website to re-enter your card number etc. Don't be fooled by the threat of hefty fines and the need to pay immediately. If in doubt don't click on any links in the email and contact the company directly using the phone number on paperwork you have or by verifying their number on Google.

Finally, it would also seem that there are still parking issues in the village. In issue 288 (December 2019) the Parish Council published a list of highway code rules. If you need a reminder you can view this edition at on the Tingewick & District News website (tingewicknews.co.uk) but as a brief reminder you shouldn't park where your vehicle causes an unnecessary obstruction (rule 242) or park opposite of or within 10 metres of a junction or where a kerb has been lowered (rule 243). There have been several near misses and a couple of prangs over recent months and I would hate for a more serious accident to occur due to a lack of considerate parking.





NEWS FROM WATER STRATFORD

OLIVER PATRICK HILSDON 1992-2019

It is very sad to record that Oli died in January. A former student at The Royal Latin School and Pembroke College, Cambridge, he had recently started his dream job with a Private Equity firm in London when he was diagnosed with an aggressive brain tumour at just twenty-two and given twelve to eighteen months to live. Oli faced his illness with extraordinary positivity, running the London Marathon, and thereby raising £60,000 for Brain Tumour Research, in under four hours only a month after radiotherapy, chemotherapy and immunotherapy, and the next day returning to work. Subsequently the cancer came back, requiring surgery and an expensive vaccine not available on the NHS, so his family and friends fund-raised for this; but part-way through treatment the illness returned. His wedding to Georgia, who had been with him throughout the ordeal, was brought forward and they married in Pembroke College chapel. Oli has been an inspiration to many, including those who never knew him, not only raising money for research into brain tumours but also raising awareness of the disease.
