

Watch out for these FAKE TalkTalk emails about a refund

Action Fraud has received over 100 reports about fake emails purporting to be from TalkTalk. The emails state that the recipient's TalkTalk account is in credit and that they're owed a refund. The links in the emails lead to malicious websites.

Don't click on the links or attachments in suspicious emails, and never respond to messages that ask for your personal or financial details.

Online Vehicle Sales Alert - The National Fraud Intelligence Bureau

What you need to know:

Fraudsters have been advertising vehicles and machinery for sale on various online selling platforms, this includes vehicles and machinery used by the agricultural industry.

The victims, after communicating via email with the fraudster, will receive a bogus email which appears to be sent by a trustworthy third party, often PayPal or Escrow.

The emails are designed to persuade victims to pay upfront via bank transfer rather than through a protected payment method via the website. The victim pays the deposit before visiting the seller to collect the goods, believing there is a 'cooling off' period to reclaim the payment if they change their mind.

This gives victims the false sense of security that their money is being looked after by this trustworthy third party, when in fact, it is not and the money has gone straight to the fraudster.

It is vital that the public exercise caution when receiving emails or messages of this nature.

What you need to do:

- Never transfer money for a vehicle you haven't seen in person.
- Avoid paying for the vehicle by bank transfer as it offers you little protection if you become a victim of fraud. Instead, use a credit card or payment services such as PayPal.
- If you're purchasing from a company or person you don't know and trust, carry out some research first, or ask friends and family for advice before completing a purchase.

HMRC Alert

What you need to know:

- Action Fraud has experienced an increase in the reporting of malicious calls and voicemails, to members of the public purporting to be from Her Majesty's Revenue & Customs (HMRC).
- Fraudsters are spoofing genuine HMRC telephone numbers to deceive their victims over the phone. The fraudsters state that as a result of the victim's non-payment of tax or other duty, the victim is liable for prosecution or other legal proceedings in order to settle the balance. The fraudsters suggest victims can avoid this, by

- arranging payment to be made immediately by methods such as bank transfer or by purchasing iTunes gift cards.
- If the victim is hesitant or refuses to comply, the suspect makes a threat such as immediate arrest, sending bailiffs to the victim's address or, in some cases, deportation.
- Often, the period for which the tax is allegedly due is distant enough to guarantee the victim will have little, if any, paperwork or ability to verify the claims. Once the money is paid the suspects sever all contact with the victim.
- In genuine cases, HMRC will initially make direct contact with you via post/letter and potentially follow up that letter with a phone call at a later date.
- If HMRC contact you via telephone they will quote the reference number on the initial letter you should have received. HMRC will not discuss something you are not already aware of, like a tax investigation, and will NOT demand immediate payment.

It is vital that the public exercise caution when receiving messages or telephone calls of this nature.

What you need to do:

- Always question unsolicited requests for your personal or financial information. Just because someone knows your basic details (such as your name and contact details), it doesn't mean they are genuine. Instead, contact the company directly using trusted methods such as a known email address or phone number.
- Legitimate organisations wouldn't ask you to pay taxes, bills or fees using an iTunes gift card, or any other type of voucher. If you're contacted by anyone that asks you to do this, you're likely the target of a scam
- Don't be rushed or pressured into making a decision. Under no circumstances would a genuine bank or some other trusted organisation force you to make a financial transaction on the spot.
- Report Phishing attempts. If you receive a call, text or email of this nature and have not lost money, you can report this as phishing to Action Fraud

PARISH MEETING AGM

The meeting took place on 17th May at 8pm in The Old School, with the 2018-19 Committee Members, twenty-six other residents and County and District Councillors in attendance.

Councillor Fealey spoke about plans for a single unitary authority for Buckinghamshire: there will be a 147 member Council with 3 Councillors per ward. Efficiency should be increased by streamlining administration. Large developments are taking place around Buckingham. The preferred option for the East-West Expressway, passing new Winslow, will go out for consultation.

Councillor Clare reported that the drainage project on the Water Stratford to Tingewick road has reduced water runr down the hill, so preventing damage to the road surface. Additional road markings have been put at Water Stratford crossroads. (The Committee has written to the Council about the dangers.) Resurfacing of Tingewick Road roundabout and Stowe Avenue are scheduled.

The Chairman said BT fibre has been extended to the bridge outside Water Stratford and to the crossroads and it she be brought into the village soon. The contribution to the maintenance of The Old School and grounds has been slig increased; there was general agreement that the hall is a valuable social resource and the contribution is warranted. Speeding traffic through the village remains a problem: 30mph sticker signs for recycling bins will be investigated. The Clerk said that funding for a defibrillator is still being sought. Following the Treasurer's report it was agreed th contribution to the redecoration of The Old School was an acceptable use of funds. There were nine planning applications during the year; the Committee returned comments on one. The condition of the A422 into Buckingha has been improved. Potholes can be reported via the BCC website. Two residents are monitoring the condition of footpaths and contacting landowners over problems. Options for replacing the hedge outside The Old School were discussed.

A new committee was elected; Rob wished to stand down as Chairman, Brian as Treasurer and Chris from the Committee. At a subsequent meeting on 6th June responsibilities were allocated as follows: Chairman – Susan, Clei Martin, Treasurer – Dawn, Planning – Rachel, Roads/Environment – Rob, Member – Brian.

The variety and number of issues covered are a reminder of how much time and thought Committee members and Councillors give to this work, to the benefit of us all – so thank you.
